GREEN PINEAPPLE SMOOTHIE

KITCHEN GEAR

Sharp knife Cutting board Measuring cup Measuring spoons Blender

INGREDIENTS

- 1 cup plain low-fat yogurt or almond milk
- 2 overripe bananas, peeled, sliced, and (ideally) frozen.
- 2 cups pineapple chunks (fresh, frozen, or unsweetened canned)
- 1 cup kale leaves with their thick stems removed, or spinach leaves, washed well
- 1 tablespoon fresh lemon juice Pinch of salt
- 2 ice cubes (if bananas weren't frozen)

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1 Put all the ingredients in the blender
- 2 Put the top on tightly. Turn the blender to a medium setting and blend until the mixture is smooth, about 1 minute. (Add up to 1 cup cold water if mixture is too thick to blend.)
- 3 Serve right away or cover and refrigerate up to 1 hour.

EFNEP

EFNEP (Expanded Food and Nutrition Education Program) is a free nutrition education program offered in several counties in Ohio for low-income adults with children and youth. Program assistants use interactive discussions and hands-on activities to guide participants through a series of meetings aimed at improving the total family diet and nutritional well-being.

The adult program teaches low-income adults with children how to make healthier food choices, manage their food resources, improve their food safety practices, and provides ideas on how to get active with their families.

The youth program teaches kids about nutrition, food preparation, food safety, and physical activity during a sixweek, interactive program in classrooms, after-school programs/camps, and summer feeding sites.

EFNEP is funded by the National Institute of Food and Agriculture (NIFA), a branch of the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA). The program operates through Extension offices at land-grant institutions in every state and in the six U.S. territories. In Ohio, EFNEP is administered by Ohio State University Extension.
