#### Letter from the 4-H Educator...

Our 2016 4-H year has officially begun!! Here in the Columbiana County Extension Office we are honored to be a part of the good people who vest their time into building our community in such positive ways. As the 4-H Educator it is wonderful to see all the youth focused individuals that help make our program happen. We will be busy in our office for the next few weeks entering all our County's 4-H Members and Volunteers into the Ohio 4-H Online system. I am very excited to see what projects our members will be taking this year.

On a side note, we are back on track for the volunteer fingerprinting. All volunteers are required to have a Background Check (BCI) before given care of our youth. As of January 1<sup>st</sup> of this year the University is reimbursing the cost of that Background check. Our office will be communicating with existing volunteers who are "due" for their re-check in 2016.

#### COMPLETED PROJECT REQUIREMENTS FOR COLUMBIANA COUNTY

To have a completed 4-H project in Columbiana County you must have a completed and graded 4-H project book.

If it is a species project (market/non market animal project), you must attend a Quality Assurance (unless otherwise noted) and you must attend 1 Clinic for your species.

If you do not have a completed project, you will not be eligible to show at Columbiana County Fair.

It is our recommendation that if you are taking multiple projects that are included in 1 project book, you should have 1 book per project. Please let your 4-H Club advisor know if you need additional books so they can order the books thorough our office for you.



#### **EFNEP (Expanded Food and Nutrition Education Program)**

Pineapple Angel Food Cake

Recipe Type: Dessert Serves: 12

Prep Time: 5 minutes Cooking Time: 40 minutes

What you need:

1 box Angel Food Cake mix

20 oz. can crushed pineapple in its own juice

Fat free whipped cream

Cooking spray

- 1. Wash your hands



#### Fulfills certification requirements

This meeting will fulfill the **three-hour** requirement for applicators who need the agricultural fertilizer applicator certification and <u>do NOT currently have a pesticide applicator license</u>. Those applicators who have a license can attend a session in conjunction with their pesticide recertification, or attend this session to meet the requirement.

#### Who needs the agricultural fertilizer certification?

Fertilizer certification is required if you apply fertilizer (other than manure) to more than 50 acres of agricultural production grown primarily for sale. If you hire a co-op or other custom applicator to make your fertilizer applications, you do not need the certification.

#### What will be covered in the training?

Best management practices will be the basis of the agricultural fertilizer certification training with a focus on fertilizer applications that have the appropriate rate, timing, placement and source.
