4-H PROJECT FAIR PROJECTS DISPLAY AT FAIR

All youth that participate in the 4-H Project Fair can display their 4-H projects during the week of fair. You can drop off your project along with your ribbons awarded to be displayed in the Junior Fair building. (Drop off your projects on Saturday, July 28th or Sunday, July 29th) you will need to sign the project in when dropping it off. All projects can be picked up after 6:00 p.m. on Sunday, August 6th.

State Fair Winners that display their project in the Junior Fair Building are eligible for the Outstanding Overall Still Project Award or the Outstanding Overall Food or Sewing Award. These awards are given out during the week of fair.

The Expanded Food and Nutrition Education Program (EFNEP) is happy to report that the youth program reached over 300 kindergarten, first and second grade students at McKinley and Southern Local Elementary Schools during the second semester of the 2017-18 school year.

TRY ONE OF OUR EFNEP RECIPES:

MANGO SALSA

Makes 8 servings (2 T per serving)

Prep Time 10 minutes

Ingredients:

- 1 mango, diced (or 1 cup thawed frozen chunks)
- 1 T minced onion (optional)
- 1 T chopped fresh cilantro (optional)
- 1/4 t salt
- 2 T lime juice
- Baked Tortilla Chips

Directions:

1. Wash fresh mango and cilantro (if using)
2. Collect, prepare, and measure all ingredients before starting to prepare the recipe.
3. Combine all ingredients in a medium bowl.
4. Serve with Baked Tortilla Chips
5. Refrigerate leftovers within 2 hours. Eat within 3 to 5 days.
