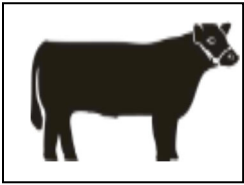
WHAT IS 4-H PROGRAM ADVISORY?

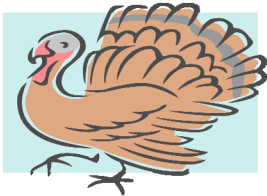


Steer Registration: If you are planning on taking the Market Steer Project to the Columbiana County Fair in 2019, you will need to register your steer.
