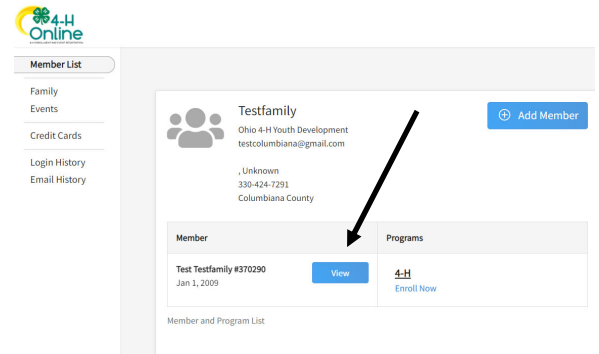




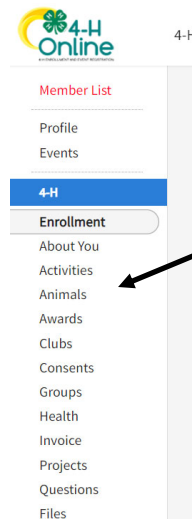
## 4-H ONLINE ANIMAL ID INSTRUCTIONS– Breeding Sheep

Step 1: Log into your 4-H online profile

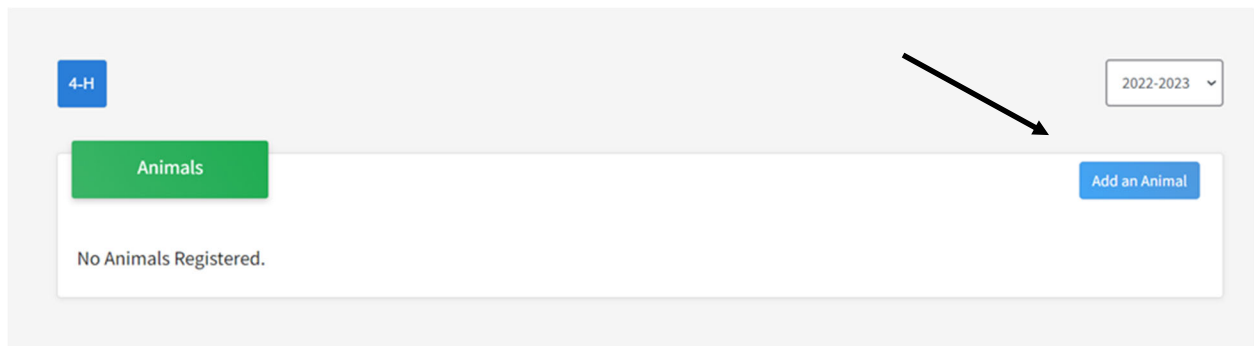
Step 2: Select the 4-H Member's name and Click on View
