

4-H Projects are a great opportunity for you to try something new!

Some of the Project Areas of Interest are:

Animal Science- projects about raising and caring for animals. (Please note most of these projects will require owning an animal.)

Science, Technology, Engineering & Math- projects that include Rockets, ATV Safety, Bicycle, Electricity, Food Science, Radio Controlled Vehicles, Robotics, Rope, Small Engines, Welding and Woodworking to name a few. Most of these projects will involve scientific principles, require problem solving and llow members to work with their hands to build or create their project.

Creative & Leisure Arts-projects that allow the youth to use their creative or artistic talents. These projects include Cake Decorating, collectibles, quilting, Fine Art, Photography, Scrapbooking, Creative Art (theater) and Writing.

Natural Resources- projects for the outdoor enthusiast. Projects include: gardening & planting, explore the Outdoors, Explore the Forest, Tree Planting, Exploring Ohio Ponds, Ohio Birds, Trapping Muskrats in Ohio, Fishing, Beekeeping, Archery, and Gun Safety

Clothing & Textiles- Learn To sew and learn how to make fashion choices

Food & Nutrition- these are projects that develop knowledge & skills in the areas of nutrition, food safety, consumer knowledge and food preparation.

Healthy Living- projects that develop knowledge about healthy life choices including nutrition, fitness and life choices.


A Glimpse from the 2015-2016 Columbiana County 4-H Ambassadors

As of 12/17/15, Ohio Department of Agriculture has lifted the poultry ban. However, we do not know at this time if the Ohio Department of Agriculture will reenact the ban at a later time during the 2016 Fair Season. 
