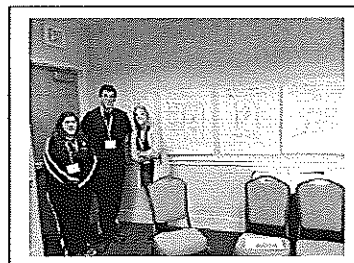
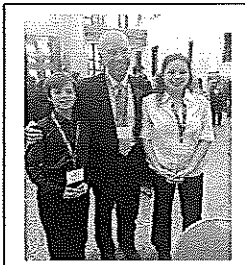
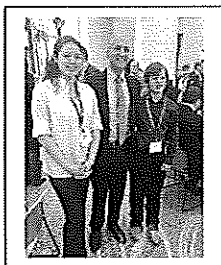

Members began practicing public speaking by doing short leadership lessons at the beginning of each meeting. Several members volunteered at the January 18th quality assurance. They helped with sign in, activities, and passing out prizes. Member Jon Black has volunteered to be the Teen Council's youth representative on the 4-H Program Advisory Committee. Member Darby Miller attended the Ohio State University Extension Legislative Luncheon on February 15th along with her mother Lacey and brother John. They learned about the many programs and opportunities that OSUE has to offer in their communities. They also got to meet local legislators and share how 4-H has impacted their lives in a positive way. Member Hannah Davis will be sharing her school community project that helps bring awareness to physical disabilities with the group next month. Member Brooke Hofmeister has agreed to represent the County at this year's Camp Ohio Leadership Camp. Member Kylie Cline attended the National Health Summit in DC and has joined the Health Heroes State Group. She will be working in her community to create more interest in the healthy living side of 4-H and marketing the positive effects that belonging to 4-H can have on overall health. She will also be working with the state group to create kits that will increase knowledge of the opiate epidemic that is plaguing our State and educate on the resources that exist in our County to address the issue. 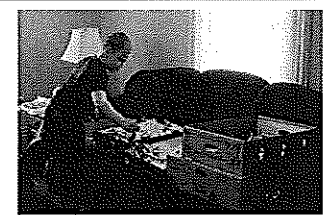

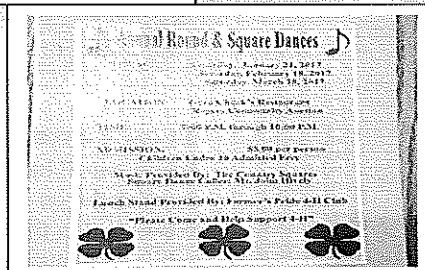
4-H CLUB CORNER

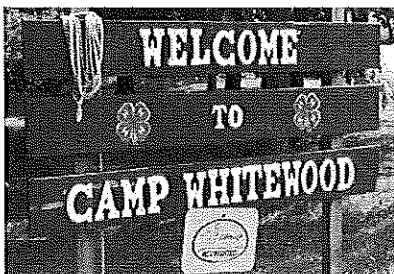

Currently Kelley is working in the CCCTC classroom, Resource Center in Lisbon, and Ohio Means Jobs

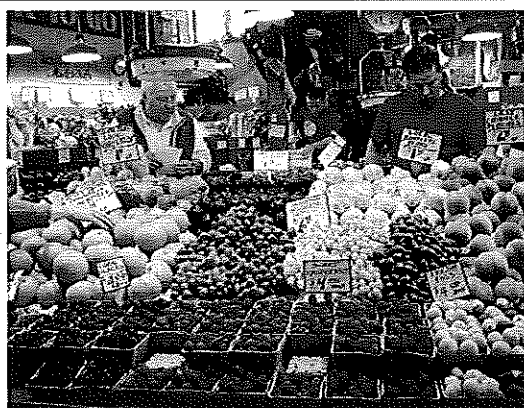


Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program

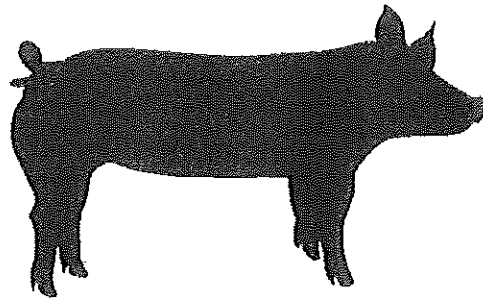
