

2021 4-H Livestock Project Completion

The 4-H Livestock Project Completion opportunity will offer a way for youth to share their knowledge, goals, and experiences from their projects.

Steps to Complete:

- 1. *Create* a PowerPoint/Slides or word document, for **one (1)** of *livestock/non livestock animal project*, that includes the following information:
 - a. *Introduction*: Member name, 4-H age (as of Jan.1), club name, number of years in 4-H, and list of projects taken. Include picture of member with projects. List specie chosen for project focus
 - b. *Topic of Interest:* Highlight (1) selected Topic of Interest from your project book and write a short statement that describes it. Depending on your age and skill level, your topic can be simple or complex (must be a different area of interest than any previous years)
 - c. **Learning Activity:** Select (1) age-appropriate opportunity to explore from an area that interests you from the list provided in the project book. Ideas are also available online at ohio4h.org/learningactivities
 - d. *Leadership and Citizenship Activities:* Select (2) activities from the list provided in the project book and describe your involvement in each activity.
 - e. **Good Production Practices:** Select (1) area of interest below and share best practice information learned. Information can be shared though pictures, drawings, and or explanations.
 - *Medication Label/ Treatment Record
 - * Feed Tag/Feed Efficiency
 - *Drug Use Notification Form /Drug Residue
 - f. **4-H Highlight:** Share your favorite 4-H Highlight from all of your 4-H experiences. Include pictures if possible.
- 2. **Present** completed document to an interviewer on July 7th (Online registration)
- 3. Awards Presentation July 8th after Still Project Fair Judging

Premier 4-H Member Award will be recognized in each age category.

First Year 4-H Member (any age)

(member must be a first-year member in all project area registered for)

Beginner (Ages 8-10 yrs.)

Intermediate (Ages 11-13 yrs.)
